- 7 (2) Disaster or Emergency Aid Funds: Subject to the conditions and
- 8 procedures in this Act, in the event of a presidentially declared disaster or emergency,
- 9 the Department of Military Affairs may request from the Finance and Administration
- 10 Cabinet, as a necessary government expense, up to \$75,000,000 in fiscal year 2023-
- 11 2024 from the General Fund to be used as required to match federal aid for which the
- state would be eligible. There is appropriated from the General Fund the necessary funds,
- 13 subject to the conditions and procedures in this Act, which are required to match federal
- 14 aid for which the state would be eligible in the event of a presidentially declared disaster
- or emergency.] These necessary funds shall be made available from the General Fund

- 19 Justice and Public Safety Cabinet, 5. Corrections, b. Adult Correctional Institutions, (3)
- 20 Operational Costs for Inmate Population, at page 1686, is amended to read as follows:
- 21 (3) Operational Costs for Inmate Population: In the event that actual
- 22 operational costs exceed the amounts appropriated to support the budgeted average daily
- population of state felons for each fiscal year, up to \$5,000,000 in fiscal year 2023-
- 24 <u>2024[the additional payments]</u> shall be deemed necessary government expenses and shall
- be paid from the General Fund Surplus Account (KRS 48.700) or the Budget Reserve
