1 AN ACT relating to training for telecommunicators. 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky: 3 → Section 1. KRS 15.550 is amended to read as follows: 4 (1) The basic course offered by the training program shall consist of forty (40) hours of 5 instruction or training and shall consist of subjects appropriate for the basic training of law enforcement telecommunicators in the technique of emergency services 6 7 communications. The Kentucky Law Enforcement Council shall approve all 8 training curriculum and instructions. 9 (2)As a portion of the basic course offered, all telecommunicators shall be trained in telephone cardiopulmonary resuscitation (T-CPR) utilizing nationally recognized 10 11 emergency cardiovascular care guidelines. This training shall incorporate 12 recognition protocols for out-of-hospital cardiac arrest, compression-only CPR instructions for callers, and continuous education. 13 14 (3) Any employee of a PSAP as defined by KRS 65.750 that answers calls for 15 emergency medical conditions shall, in the appropriate circumstances, provide telephonic assistance in administering CPR directly or transfer calls to a 16 17 dedicated phone line, call center, or other public safety answering point (PSAP) 18 to provide the caller with assistance in administering T-CPR.
