| 3 | → SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 216B IS CREATED TO |
| 4 | READ AS FOLLOWS: |
| 5 | (1) All health facilities shall follow pressure sore prevention and treatment protocols |
| 6 | approved by the cabinet to ensure that a person receiving health services: |
| 7 | (a) Receives adequate supervision and assistive devices to prevent the |
| 8 | development of pressure sores while on the premises of the facility; and |
| 9 | (b) Receives necessary treatment and services to promote healing, prevent |
| 10 | infection, and prevent new sores from developing if a person has pressure |
| 11 | sores upon entrance to the facility or develops pressure sores while on the |
| 12 | premises of the facility. |
| 13 | (2) The cabinet shall promulgate administrative regulations to enforce this section, |
| 14 | including approved pressure sore prevention and treatment protocols and |
| 15 | provisions to impose monetary fines for willful violations of this section. |
| 16 | → Section 2. Section 1 of this Act may be cited as the Bridget Ann Howard Act or |
| 17 | the Bridget Bill. |
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
