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1	An Act telating to an emergency contact information registry.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS 186.400 TO 186.640 IS CREATED
4	TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) The Transportation Cabinet shall establish and maintain an emergency contact
6	information registry within the Kentucky Driver's License Information System
7	which shall be capable of storing next of kin or other emergency contact
8	information of persons to whom it issues identity documents. Information in the
9	registry shall be accessible only to employees of the Transportation Cabinet and
10	to law enforcement officials and shall not be subject to the Kentucky Open
11	Records Act, KRS 61.870 to 61.884.
12	(2) When an individual submits an application for an initial or renewal of an identity
13	document, the individual shall be furnished with an emergency contact
14	information form, prepared by the Transportation Cabinet, on which the
15	individual may list the name, address, telephone number, and relationship to the
16	individual of at least one (1) contact person whom the individual wishes to be
17	contacted if the individual dies, is seriously injured, or is rendered unconscious
18	and unable to communicate with his or her emergency contact person.
19	(3) The contact person may or may not be the next of kin of the applicant, except that
20	if the applicant is under eighteen (18) years of age and is not emancipated, the
21	contact person shall include the parent, guardian, or custodian of the applicant.
22	(4) The secretary of the Transportation Cabinet shall promulgate administrative
23	regulations under KRS Chapter 13A to establish the rules to implement the
24	emergency contact registry established under this section, including but no
25	limited to:
26	(a) The contents of the emergency contact information form;
27	(b) Where the individual may submit the completed form; and

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1		(c) How a person who has submitted the name of a contact person for inclusion
2		in the database may revise or update the emergency contact information.
3	<u>(5)</u>	In the event of a motor vehicle accident or emergency situation in which a person
4		dies, is seriously injured, or is rendered unconscious and unable to communicate
5		with the contact person specified in the database, law enforcement personnel
6		shall make a good-faith effort to notify the contact person of the situation.
7		However, the Transportation Cabinet, law enforcement personnel, and law
8		enforcement agencies shall not be held liable if they are unable to make contact
9		with the contact person.
