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1	AN ACT relating to criminal history record checks.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 620 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section, "emergency placement" means those limited instances
6	when the Cabinet for Health and Family Services' Department for Community
7	Based Services is placing a child in the home of private individuals, including
8	neighbors, friends, or relatives, as a result of a sudden unavailability of the
9	child's primary caregiver.
10	(2) (a) During an emergency placement when a child must be placed in home care
11	due to the absence of parents or custodians, the Department for Community
12	Based Services may request that a criminal justice agency perform a federal
13	name-based criminal history record check of each adult residing in the
14	<u>home;</u>
15	(b) Name-based check results may be provided to the Department for
16	Community Based Services, which shall then provide a complete set of each
17	adult resident's fingerprints to the Department of Kentucky State Police for
18	the immediate submission to the Federal Bureau of Investigation within
19	fourteen (14) calendar days from the date the name search was conducted;
20	(c) The Department of Kentucky State Police shall either positively identify the
21	fingerprint subject or forward the fingerprints to the Federal Bureau of
22	Investigation within fifteen (15) calendar days from the day the name
23	search was conducted; and
24	(d) The child shall be removed from the home immediately if any adult resident
25	fails to provide his or her fingerprints and written permission to perform a
26	federal criminal history record check when requested.
27	(3) When placement of a child in a home is denied as a result of a name-based

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1		criminal history record check of a resident, and the resident contests that denial,
2		each contesting resident shall, within fifteen (15) calendar days, submit to the
3		Department for Community Based Services a complete set of the resident's
4		fingerprints with written permission allowing the Department for Community
5		Based Services to forward the fingerprints to the Department of Kentucky State
6		Police for submission to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
7	<u>(4)</u>	The Department of Kentucky State Police and the Federal Bureau of
8		Investigation may each charge a reasonable fee for processing a fingerprint-
9		based criminal history record check.
