6	following with the capacity to serve one thousand five hundred (1,500) or more

8	(a) A building, structure, or facility owned by the Commonwealth;

10	including but not limited to a movie theater, performance theater, concert
11	hall, convention center, store that is larger than forty thousand (40,000)
12	square feet, or shopping mall;
13	(c) A building, structure, or facility used for public display or collection,
14	including but not limited to a museum, library, or gallery;
15	(d) A place of recreation, including but not limited to a park, zoo, or

17	(e) Any of the following:

20	3. An interstate rest area;
21	4. A place of education;
22	5. A hospital; or
23	6. A rehabilitation facility.
