AN ACT relating to the revocation of receipt or provision of public assistance due to fraudulent use.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- →SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 205 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
- (1) As used in this section, "public assistance program" means any federal- or statefunded program managed or administered by the cabinet, including but not
  limited to the Medicaid Assistance Program, the Supplemental Nutrition
  Assistance Program (SNAP), the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for
  Women, Infants and Children (WIC), Kentucky Transitional Assistance Program
  (KTAP), Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Social Security Disability Income
  (SSDI), Low-Income Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), Community
  Services Block Grant (CSBG), and the Child Care Assistance Program that
  provides money grants, assistance in kind, or services to or for the benefit of
  needy aged persons, needy blind persons, needy permanently and totally disabled
  persons, needy children, persons with whom a needy child lives, or a family
  containing a combination of these categories.
- (2) A public assistance program benefit recipient or benefit provider whose eligibility

  to receive or provide public assistance program benefits has been revoked due to

  defrauding a public assistance program shall not be eligible for future benefits

  from a public assistance program.
- (3) The cabinet shall request any waivers of federal law that are necessary to implement this section.
- (4) Nothing in this section shall authorize the cabinet to waive the recipient's or provider's rights to prior notice and hearing as guaranteed by federal law.
