1	AN ACT relating to insurance for motor vehicle repairs.	
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:	
3	→ Section 1. KRS 304.12-275 is amended to read as follows:	
4	(1) (a) An insurer shall inform a claimant upon notification of a motor vehicle	
5	damage claim that he or she has the right to choose the repair facility of his or	
6	her choice to repair a damaged vehicle.	
7	$(\underline{b})$ [(2)] After July 12, 2012, all appraisals shall include the following notice,	
8	printed in not less than ten (10) point, boldfaced type: "NOTICE: UNDER	
9	KENTUCKY LAW, THE CONSUMER AND/OR LESSEE HAS THE	
10	RIGHT TO CHOOSE THE REPAIR FACILITY TO MAKE REPAIRS TO	
11	HIS OR HER MOTOR VEHICLE."	
12	(2) (a) An insurer making a payment for motor vehicle repairs shall pay a fair and	
13	reasonable amount for the repairs.	
14	(b) When determining the amount that shall be paid for motor vehicle repairs,	
15	the insurer shall not rely on or consider survey data.	
16	(3) The obligations set forth in this section shall not apply to the replacement or repair	
17	of automobile glass.	
18	→ Section 2. KRS 304.99-112 is amended to read as follows:	
19	Any person who violates KRS 304.12-275(1) shall be subject, at the discretion of the	
20	commissioner, to a fine in an amount of not less than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) nor	
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- 21 more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000). Each violation shall constitute a separate
- 22 offense.
