26	(1)	At a regularly scheduled interval, each enrollment or benefit tracking agency		
27		associated with the Medicaid program or the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance		

Program of the cabinet shall receive and review information from the Kentucky Lottery Corporation concerning individuals enrolled as recipients in the Medicaid program or the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program that indicates a change in circumstances that may affect eligibility, including but not limited to changes in income or resources.

- (2) On at least a monthly basis, each enrollment or benefit tracking agency associated with the Medicaid program or the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program of the cabinet shall receive and review information from the Vital Statistics Branch concerning individuals enrolled in the Medicaid program or the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program that indicates a change in circumstances that may affect eligibility.
- (3) On at least a quarterly basis, each enrollment or benefit tracking agency associated with the Medicaid program or the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program of the cabinet shall receive and review information from the Kentucky Office of Unemployment Insurance concerning individuals enrolled in the Medicaid program or the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program that indicates a change in circumstances that may affect eligibility, including but not limited to changes in employment or wages.
 - (4) On at least a quarterly basis, each enrollment or benefit tracking agency associated with the Medicaid program or the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program of the cabinet shall receive and review information concerning individuals enrolled in the Medicaid program or the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program that indicates a change in circumstances that may affect eligibility, including but not limited to potential changes in residency as identified by out-of-state electronic benefit transfer transactions.
- 26 (5) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary:
 - (a) Each enrollment or benefit tracking agency associated with the Medicaid

program or the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program of the cabinet shall enter into a memorandum of understanding with any department, agency, or division for information detailed in this section; and

- (b) Any department, agency, or division for information detailed in this section, including but not limited to the Kentucky Lottery Corporation, the Vital Statistics Branch, the Office of Unemployment Insurance, and the Department for Community Based Services, shall enter into any necessary memoranda of understanding with the enrollment or benefit tracking agency associated with the Medicaid program or the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program requesting an agreement pursuant to paragraph (a) of this subsection.
- (6) Each enrollment or benefit tracking agency associated with the Medicaid program or the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program of the cabinet may contract in accordance with KRS Chapter 45A with one (1) or more independent vendors to provide additional data or information that may indicate a change in circumstances that may affect eligibility.
- (7) Each enrollment or benefit tracking agency associated with the Medicaid program or the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program of the cabinet shall explore joining any multistate cooperative to identify individuals who are also enrolled in public assistance programs outside of this state.
