3		→Section 1. KRS 176.431 is amended to read as follows:
4	(1)	( <i>a</i> ) Notwithstanding any conflicting provisions of this chapter and KRS Chapters
5		45A and 177, each fiscal year, the Transportation Cabinet is authorized to
6		utilize design/build procurement methods for up to:
7		<u>1.</u> Five (5) <u>major</u> demonstration road and bridge related projects, with a
8		total cost of each project not to exceed three hundred million dollars
9		<u>(\$300,000,000); and</u>
10		2. Ten (10) demonstration road and bridge related projects, with a total
11		cost of each project not to exceed seventy-five million dollars
12		<u>(\$75,000,000)[in each fiscal year]</u> .
13		(b) The projects <i>outlined in this subsection</i> shall be identified in the biennial
14		highway construction plan [ and shall be limited to those with a construction
15		phase not greater than thirty million dollars (\$30,000,000)].
16	(2)	For procurement purposes, the Transportation Cabinet shall utilize a qualifications-
17		based bidding process within the context of the provisions of this chapter. The
18		projects shall be selected based on engineering factors that determine a design/build
19		process will provide the best value for the Commonwealth. Factors to consider may
20		include but not be limited to the following: project delivery schedule, technical
21		complexity, constructability, and estimated project cost.
22	(3)	The secretary of the Transportation Cabinet shall determine the nature and scope of
23		each design/build project, and shall submit a report identifying and detailing the
24		demonstration road and bridge related projects, including the estimated cost
25		savings, to the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue by
26		December 1 of each fiscal year.

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
