1	AN ACT relating to legislative procedures for state fiscal measures.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 6 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section, "state fiscal measure" means any bill, resolution,
6	or amendment thereto that either would provide for the appropriation of
7	funds by the General Assembly under Section 230 of the Constitution of
8	Kentucky, or would constitute a revenue-raising measure under Section 47
9	of the Constitution of Kentucky.
0	(2) The director of the Legislative Research Commission shall, upon the
1	request of a General Assembly member for the drafting of a state fiscal
2	measure, or upon a determination by the Senate or House of
3	Representatives or a committee of either that an item of legislation is a state
4	fiscal measure, cause the measure to be identified as such. Upon the
5	prefiling or filing of the state fiscal measure, the director shall note the
6	measure's identification in the prefiled bill list, in the Legislative Record,
17	and upon the electronic bill books in the Senate and House chambers. The
8	Senate and House clerks shall note the measure's identification on the
9	Senate and House journals.
20	(3) All state fiscal measures voted upon by the Senate or House of
21	Representatives shall be by a roll call vote of the yeas and nays, to be
22	entered on the Senate or House journal by the Senate or House clerk.
23	(4) All motions concerning a state fiscal measure adopted by the Senate or
24	House of Representatives shall be by a roll call vote of the yeas and nays, to
25	be entered on the Senate or House journal.
26	(5) No state fiscal measure shall be placed upon a consent calendar. A state
27	fiscal measure shall be considered and voted upon for all readings and

1		motions separately from other bills or resolutions.
2	<u>(6)</u>	All state fiscal measures voted upon by a standing committee of the Senate
3		or House of Representatives shall be by a roll call vote of the yeas and nays,
4		to be entered upon the records of the committee, and transmitted to the
5		Senate or House clerk, who shall enter the record of the committee vote on
6		the Senate or House journal in full.
