

1 AN ACT relating to transportation.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 189.030 is amended to read as follows:

4 (1) Headlamps, when required on a vehicle, shall be illuminated:

5 (a) During the period from one-half (1/2) hour after sunset to one-half (1/2) hour
6 before sunrise;~~and~~

7 (b) *During periods when rain, mist, snow, or other precipitation necessitates*
8 *the use of windshield wipers; and*

9 (c) At such other times as atmospheric conditions render visibility as low as or
10 lower than is ordinarily the case during that period.

11 (2) Provisions *in KRS 189.040* as to distances that lights must be visible refer to
12 visibility under ordinary atmospheric conditions.

13 ➔Section 2. On or after the effective date of this Act and prior to January 1, 2023,
14 a person who violates subsection (1)(b) of Section 1 of this Act shall not be issued a
15 uniform citation, but shall instead receive a courtesy warning. On or after January 1,
16 2023, the penalties outlined in KRS 189.990(1) shall apply.
