9	(4)	"Network" or "KentuckyWired" means the Commonwealth's open-access

11	(5)	"Paid prioritization" means an Internet service provider directly or indirectly

18	<u>(6)</u>	"Partnership" means the public-private partnership entered into between the

22	154	IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
23	<u>(1)</u>	Any contract entered into on or after the effective date of this Act between the
24		authority and any public or private Internet service provider whereby the
25		provider, in provision of broadband service, has access to KentuckyWired shall
26		prohibit a provider from:
27		(a) Blocking lawful content, applications, services, or nonharmful devices;

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1		(b) Impairing or degrading lawful Internet traffic on the basis of Internet
2		content, application, service, or the uses of nonharmful devices;
3		(c) Engaging in paid prioritization; and
4		(d) Assigning data caps to broadband services provided through
5		KentuckyWired.
6	(2)	Any such contract shall provide access to KentuckyWired on a nonexclusive,
7		nonpreferential basis.
8	<u>(3)</u>	The authority shall terminate a contract with any provider that violates the
9		requirements of this section.
