2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

→ Section 1. KRS 12.020 is amended to read as follows:

4 Departments, program cabinets and their departments, and the respective major 5 administrative bodies that they include are enumerated in this section. It is not intended 6 that this enumeration of administrative bodies be all-inclusive. Every authority, board, 7 bureau, interstate compact, commission, committee, conference, council, office, or any 8 other form of organization shall be included in or attached to the department or program 9 cabinet in which they are included or to which they are attached by statute or statutorily 10 authorized executive order; except in the case of the Personnel Board and where the 11 attached department or administrative body is headed by a constitutionally elected officer, 12 the attachment shall be solely for the purpose of dissemination of information and 13 coordination of activities and shall not include any authority over the functions, 14 personnel, funds, equipment, facilities, or records of the department or administrative 15 body.

7 The Tourism, Arts and Heritage Cabinet shall consist of the Office of the Secretary, (1)8 the Office of Legal Affairs, the Office of Finance, the Office of Government 9 Relations and Administration, the Office of Human Resources, the Office of Public 10 Affairs and Constituent Services, the Office of Arts and Cultural Heritage, the 11 Office of Film and Tourism Development, the Kentucky Department of Tourism, 12 the Kentucky Department of Parks, the Tourism Development Finance Authority, 13 and such other divisions and sections as are from time to time deemed necessary for 14 the proper and efficient operation of the cabinet subject to the provisions of KRS 15 Chapter 12.

 17 film industry in Kentucky and shall perform all film promotional functions.
- 18 (3) The Office of Legal Affairs shall be headed by a general counsel appointed by the
 19 secretary pursuant to KRS 12.210, shall provide legal services for the cabinet, and
 20 shall be directly responsible to the secretary.
- (4) The Kentucky Department of Tourism shall be headed by a commissioner appointed
 by the Governor pursuant to the provisions of KRS 12.040. The commissioner shall
 have the authority and responsibility for the promotion, development, and support
 services for the tourism industry within the Commonwealth.
- (5) The Divisions of Tourism Services, Marketing[<u>and Administration</u>], <u>Tourism</u>

4	(1)	The Division of Tourism Services shall <i>provide support to the tourism industry by</i>
5		managing the Tourism Marketing Incentive Program, which is a collaborative
6		effort with industry partners to utilize the one percent (1%) lodging tax funds
7		effectively by providing matching funds for marketing and promotional efforts.
8		The division shall staff and manage the seven (7) state welcome centers located in
9		Franklin, Grayson, Hopkinsville, Shelbyville, Shepherdsville, Williamsburg, and
10		Whitehaven to provide visitor and travel information. The division shall also
11		provide travel brochure fulfillment for public and industry requests [operate the
12		highway welcome centers, conduct a hospitality education program for the tourism
13		industry, coordinate the provision of mail and telephone information services to

16	(2)	The Division of Marketing [and Advertising]shall be responsible for marketing
17		Kentucky as a travel destination on a state, regional, national, and international
18		level and creating and developing marketing materials in conjunction with the
19		Commissioner's Office. The division shall maintain a database of all the tourism-
20		related attractions, destinations, and events. The division shall promote these
21		assets through a variety of mediums including but not limited to television, radio,
22		print, out of-home, over-the-top, and digital. Additionally, the division shall
23		participate in trade shows, events, and conferences to showcase the state. The
24		division also shall collaborate with industry partners within the state and
25		throughout the region to leverage marketing efforts. The division shall manage
26		the department's Web site as well as the production of the official visitor's guide.
27		The division shall also guide the efforts of the cultural heritage tourism program

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1		for Kentucky[state tourism advertising, the state matching fund tourism advertising			
2		program, the development and maintenance of a marketing and research database on			
3		tourism, market survey programs, and special studies related to the tourism			
4		industry].			
5	(3)	The Division of Communications and Public Relations shall work to complement			
6		the activities of the department's advertising programs by engaging media and			
7		employing other strategies that publicize Kentucky's attractions and events as			
8		tourism destinations. These efforts shall primarily focus on generating earned			
9		broadcast and print media to support the marketing efforts of the department.			
10		This division shall serve as the liaison with media sources, maintaining constant			
11		contact through social media, e-newsletters, and a Web-based media resource			
12		site. It shall provide assistance to individual media representatives and travel			
13		writers in a variety of ways, including but not limited to creating story ideas,			
14		making travel arrangements, and providing photographs, video, and fact			
15		verification. It shall prepare regular press releases for the department to keep the			
16		public abreast of attractions and events in Kentucky. The goal of the division is to			
17		provide comprehensive support for projects and promotions developed through			
18		the department on behalf of the tourism industry in Kentucky.			
19	<u>(4)</u>	The Division of Tourism Development shall oversee the administration of the			
20		Kentucky Tourism Development Finance Authority and the Kentucky Tourism			
21		Development Act and incentives. The division shall also administer film			
22		incentives and provide staff to educate the public on all incentive programs the			
23		cabinet has to offer.
