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1	AN ACT relating to pharmacy benefits.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→ SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF SUBCHAPTER 17A OF KRS CHAPTER
4	304 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section:
6	(a) "Cost sharing" means the cost to an individual insured under a health
7	benefit plan according to any coverage limit, copayment, coinsurance,
8	deductible, or other out-of-pocket expense requirements imposed by the
9	plan;
10	(b) ''Insurer'' includes:
11	1. An insurer offering a health benefit plan providing coverage for
12	pharmacy benefits; or
13	2. Any other administrator of pharmacy benefits under a health benefit
14	<u>plan;</u>
15	(c) "Pharmacy benefit manager" has the same meaning as in KRS 304.17A-
16	<u>161; and</u>
17	(d) ''Pharmacy'' includes:
18	1. A pharmacy;
19	2. A pharmacist licensed under KRS Chapter 218A; or
20	3. Any employee of a pharmacy or pharmacist.
21	(2) An insurer issuing or renewing a health benefit plan on or after the effective date
22	of this Act or pharmacy benefit manager shall not:
23	(a) Require an insured purchasing a prescription drug to pay a cost-sharing
24	amount greater than the amount the insured would pay for the drug if he or
25	she were to purchase the drug without coverage under a health benefit
26	<u>plan;</u>
27	(b) Prohibit a pharmacy from discussing any information under subsection (3)

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1		of this section; and
2		(c) Impose a penalty on a pharmacy for complying with this section.
3	<u>(3)</u>	A pharmacist shall have the right to provide an insured information regarding
4		the applicable limitations on his or her cost-sharing pursuant to this section for a
5		prescription drug.
6	<u>(4)</u>	Any amount paid by an insured under subsection (2)(a) of this section shall be
7		attributable toward any annual out-of-pocket maximums under the insured's
8		health benefit plan.
9		→ Section 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2019.
