1	AN ACT relating to child abuse and neglect.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 199 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section, unless the context otherwise requires:
6	(a) ''Abused or neglected child'' has the same meaning as in KRS 600.020; and
7	(b) ''Central registry'' means the registry for child abuse and neglect
8	established in subsection (2) of this section.
9	(2) The cabinet shall, by July 1, 2017, establish and operate the central registry for
10	child abuse and neglect. The central registry shall include the name, age, last
11	known city of residence, a photograph if available, a description of the
12	substantiated finding of abuse or neglect, and any other identifying information
13	determined necessary by the cabinet, of each individual:
14	(a) Who has been found by the cabinet to have abused or neglected a child; and
15	(b) 1. Who waived the right to appeal a substantiated finding of child abuse
16	or neglect in accordance with Kentucky law or administrative
17	regulations; or
18	2. Whose substantiated incident was upheld upon appeal.
19	(3) The cabinet shall publish the central registry on its Web site and it shall be
20	searchable and available to the public.
21	(4) The cabinet shall update the central registry every thirty (30) days.
22	(5) The cabinet shall ensure that the following statement is displayed on the cabinet
23	Web site where the central registry is published: "Based on information
24	submitted to the cabinet, an individual whose name appears on the central
25	registry has been found by the cabinet to have abused or neglected a child.
26	However, information on the central registry may not be complete."
27	(6) The cabinet shall promulgate administrative regulations to establish and operate

1	the central registry including but not limited to policies and procedures:
2	(a) For compiling, publishing, and maintaining the information required in
3	subsection (2) of this section;
4	(b) For how long an individual shall remain on the central registry;
5	(c) For how an individual may be removed from the central registry; and
6	(d) To ensure compliance with all other state and federal laws.
7	→ Section 2. This Act shall be cited as Sophie's Law.
