- 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- 3 → SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 525 IS CREATED TO
- 4 READ AS FOLLOWS:
- 5 A person is guilty of masking when the person conceals his or her physical identity
- 6 while engaging in a public protest, demonstration, or march by intentionally wearing a
- 7 mask, hood, or other device that hides, conceals, or covers any portion of his or her
- 8 face for the purpose of escaping discovery, recognition, or identification in the
- 9 <u>commission of a crime. Masking is a Class D felony.</u>
