3		→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 278 IS CREATED TO
4	REA	D AS FOLLOWS:
5	<u>(1)</u>	Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3) of this section and subject to any
6		more restrictive setback requirements under this chapter, no stand-alone,
7		ground-mounted electric generating facility that generates electricity using solar
8		energy and has a rated capacity of greater than five megawatts (5 MW) shall be
9		built within one hundred (100) feet of the boundary line of an adjoining
10		residential property on which a residence exists at the time of the commencement
11		of the construction of the solar electric generating facility. The setback distance
12		shall be measured from the closest electric module or solar panel to the nearest
13		adjoining residential property line to which the setback requirement would apply.
14		The setback requirement under this subsection may be waived by the owner of the
15		adjoining residential property, and for a merchant electric generating facility
16		subject to KRS 278.704, may be subject to deviation in accordance with KRS
17		<u>278.704(4).</u>
18	<u>(2)</u>	If a solar electric generating facility that would be subject to the setback
19		requirement of subsection (1) of this section is to be built within the jurisdiction
20		of a planning unit as defined in KRS 100.111, then any setback requirements
21		relating to the location of the solar electric generating facility established by the
22		planning unit at any time shall supersede the setback requirement established in
23		subsection (1) of this section.
24	<u>(3)</u>	If a solar electric generating facility lies across the boundary lines of two (2) or
25		more adjoining properties, then no setback distance shall be required between
26		those properties under subsection (1) of this section.
27	<i>(4)</i>	In addition to all other powers conferred to it under this chapter, the commission
