1 AN ACT relating to trial commissioners.

## 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- 3 → Section 1. KRS 24A.100 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (1) In any county which does not have a District Judge resident in the county there shall
- 5 be a trial commissioner.
- 6 (2) Trial commissioners shall be appointed in the manner required by Section 113 of
- 7 the Constitution of Kentucky and shall perform[such] duties as may be directed by
- 8 the Supreme Court.
- 9 (3) Trial commissioners in District Court shall be compensated as provided in the
- judicial personnel system, provided, however that no trial commissioner shall be
- 11 compensated at a rate greater than <u>ten thousand five hundred dollars</u>
- 12 (\$10,500)\[\text{fseven thousand two hundred dollars (\$7,200)}\] per year. Except that
- during the disability or suspension of a District Judge for a period in excess of sixty
- 14 (60) days, a trial commissioner who is qualified as an attorney and who is
- authorized to perform extraordinary duties, may be compensated by the Supreme
- 16 Court in an amount not exceeding the salary of a District Judge, provided *the*[such]
- trial commissioner shall not engage in the practice of law during the period of
- 18 extraordinary service.
