1 AN ACT relating to the commissioner of education.

## 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- 3 → Section 1. KRS 156.148 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (1) [Effective January 1, 1991, ]The commissioner of education shall be the chief state
- school officer. He *or she* shall possess the professional qualifications determined by
- 6 the Kentucky Board of Education as appropriate for the office.
- 7 (2) The commissioner shall:
- 8 (a) Be appointed by the Kentucky Board of Education, subject to Senate
- 9 <u>confirmation in accordance with KRS 11.160;</u>
- 10 (b) Serve at the pleasure of the board  $[\cdot, \cdot]$ ; and
- 11 (c) Receive compensation as set by the board, the provisions of KRS 64.640
- 12 notwithstanding.
- 13 (3) The commissioner of education shall be the executive and administrative officer of
- the Kentucky Board of Education in its administration of all educational matters
- and functions placed under its management and control. He *or she* shall carry out
- all duties assigned to him <u>or her</u> by law; shall execute under the direction of the
- state board the educational policies, orders, directives, and administrative functions
- of the board; and shall direct the work of all persons employed in the Department of
- 19 Education.
- 20 (4) The commissioner of education shall be reimbursed for all actual and necessary
- 21 traveling expenses incurred by him <u>or her</u> in the performance of his <u>or her</u> duties.
