AN ACT relating to cat declawing.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- →SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 258 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
- (1) As used in this section:
  - (a) "Cat" and "veterinarian" have the same meaning as in KRS 258.005; and
  - (b) "Declawing" means the surgical amputation of all or part of the cat's third phalanges and the attached claws.
- (2) Only a licensed veterinarian may perform a declaw procedure on a cat and no declaw procedure may be performed on a cat less than three (3) months of age.

  Prior to the declaw procedure, the veterinarian shall inform the cat's owner of the:
  - (a) Physical consequences of the declaw procedure, including impact to the function of the cat's paw, gait, weight shift, pain, or deterioration of the joints after the procedure;
  - (b) Potential pain endured by the cat during the procedure; and
  - (c) Potential alternatives to the declaw procedure.
