

1 AN ACT relating to actions of the General Assembly.

2 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

3 ➔SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 6 IS CREATED TO
4 READ AS FOLLOWS:

5 *(1) The President of the Senate on behalf of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of*
6 *Representatives on behalf of the House, or the President of the Senate and the*
7 *Speaker of the House of Representatives jointly on behalf of the General*
8 *Assembly, may intervene in any action filed in any court challenging the*
9 *constitutionality or validity of any legislative act or any Kentucky:*

10 *(a) Statute;*

11 *(b) Executive order;*

12 *(c) Administrative regulation; or*

13 *(d) Order of any cabinet, program cabinet, or department established under*
14 *KRS Chapter 12.*

15 *(2) Nothing in this section is intended to waive, nor shall it be construed, interpreted,*
16 *or applied to waive or abrogate in any way, any legislative immunity or legislative*
17 *privilege of the General Assembly, or any member of the General Assembly, as*
18 *provided by the Constitution of Kentucky, any Kentucky statute, or federal or*
19 *state common law.*

20 *(3) In all matters relating to the General Assembly or its members, legislative*
21 *immunity and legislative privilege shall be applied and interpreted as broadly as*
22 *constitutionally permissible and shall remain inviolate unless specifically and*
23 *explicitly waived by the General Assembly.*
