3		→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 6 IS CREATED TO
4	REA	AD AS FOLLOWS:
5	<u>(1)</u>	The President of the Senate on behalf of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of
6		Representatives on behalf of the House, or the President of the Senate and the
7		Speaker of the House of Representatives jointly on behalf of the General
8		Assembly, may intervene in any action filed in any court challenging the
9		constitutionality or validity of any legislative act or any Kentucky:
10		(a) Statute;
11		(b) Executive order;
12		(c) Administrative regulation; or
13		(d) Order of any cabinet, program cabinet, or department established under
14		KRS Chapter 12.
15	<u>(2)</u>	Nothing in this section is intended to waive, nor shall it be construed, interpreted,
16		or applied to waive or abrogate in any way, any legislative immunity or legislative
17		privilege of the General Assembly, or any member of the General Assembly, as
18		provided by the Constitution of Kentucky, any Kentucky statute, or federal or
19		state common law.
20	<u>(3)</u>	In all matters relating to the General Assembly or its members, legislative
21		immunity and legislative privilege shall be applied and interpreted as broadly as
22		constitutionally permissible and shall remain inviolate unless specifically and
23		explicitly waived by the General Assembly.
