AN ACT relating to religious freedom.

2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

Section 1. KRS 446.350 is amended to read as follows:

- 4 (1) Government shall not substantially burden a person's freedom of religion. The right
 5 to act or refuse to act in a manner motivated by a sincerely held religious belief may
 6 not be substantially burdened unless the government proves by clear and convincing
 7 evidence that it has a compelling governmental interest in infringing the specific act
 8 or refusal to act and has used the least restrictive means to further that interest. A
 9 "burden" shall include indirect burdens such as withholding benefits, assessing
 10 penalties, or an exclusion from programs or access to facilities.
- 11(2) The Commonwealth waives its sovereign immunity as to any claim seeking12equitable relief, as well as reasonable attorney fees and costs, brought in state or
- 13 <u>federal court under this section to adjudicate or decree a violation of this section.</u>

 The Commonwealth shall not be liable for any monetary damages arising from
