

1 AN ACT relating to state government.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 61.110 is amended to read as follows:

4 State officers who are required, in the discharge of their duties, to remain at the state
5 capital more than three (3) months in each year, may, with their families, temporarily
6 reside at the state capital for any space of time during the term for which they were
7 elected or appointed, without changing or losing their legal and permanent residence in
8 the district and precinct in which they resided at the time of their temporary removal.
9 Such officers and their families shall for all purposes be regarded as residents of the
10 precinct and district from which they removed. In all cases it shall be necessary for the
11 officer so intending to temporarily remove to file and cause to be recorded, in the clerk's
12 office of the county judge/executive of the county of his *or her* residence and in the
13 clerk's office of the county judge/executive of Franklin County, a statement of such
14 intention.
