1 AN ACT relating to school population changes, making an appropriation therefor,

- 2 and declaring an emergency.
- 3 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- Section 1. Notwithstanding KRS 157.360(9), for the 2022-2023 school year, a
- 5 district's funding from the Support Education Excellence in Kentucky program shall be
- 6 increased when the 2020-2021 end of year membership in the district is greater than the
- 7 2018-2019 end of year membership. The program funds allotted to the district shall be
- 8 increased by the percent of the adjusted increase. The adjusted increase shall be
- 9 calculated by taking the percentage growth in membership and multiplying that number
- by the district's 2018-2019 adjusted average daily attendance.
- → Section 2. Notwithstanding KRS 157.360(10), if the 2020-2021 end of year
- membership of a district decreases by three percent (3%) or more than the 2018-2019 end
- of year membership, the average daily attendance for purposes of calculating program
- funding for the 2023-2024 school year, shall be increased by an amount equal to one-half
- (1/2) of the decrease in end of year membership.
- Section 3. There is hereby appropriated General Fund moneys in the amount of
- 17 \$12,500,000 in fiscal year 2022-2023 and \$22,400,000 in fiscal year 2023-2024 to the
- 18 Support Education Excellence in Kentucky budget unit for the purposes of carrying out
- 19 Section 1 and Section 2 of this Act.
- 20 → Section 4. Due to the need to ensure school districts can accurately create
- 21 budgets for the upcoming biennium and adjust for the district population growth or loss,
- 22 an emergency is declared to exist, and this Act takes effect upon its passage and approval
- by the Governor or upon its otherwise becoming a law.
