1 AN ACT relating to natural resources.

## 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- 3 → Section 1. KRS 350.156 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (1) After restoration of the acquired land, the cabinet may, with the approval of the
- Governor, transfer jurisdiction of <u>the</u>[such] land, or any portion thereof, to any state
- 6 agency that can best utilize <u>the</u>[such] land for public purposes.
- 7 (2) If the retention of <u>the[such]</u> land is determined to be impractical, the cabinet may,
- 8 with the approval of the Governor, sell *the*[such] land to political subdivisions of
- 9 the Commonwealth at the:
- 10 (a) Cost of acquisition and restoration; or
- 11 (b) Auction price at a public sale to the highest bidder.
- 12 (3) The[Such] land shall be sold subject to the condition that no surface coal mining
- shall be conducted at any point after the restoration of the acquired land [carried]
- on thereon at any time thereafter. The proceeds of any [such ]sale of lands
- 15 <u>acquired pursuant to this section</u> shall be credited to a revolving fund within the
- cabinet.
- 17 (3) Whenever the cabinet expends funds pursuant to this section in order to satisfy the
- total purchase price for lands purchased pursuant to KRS 350.570, the cabinet may
- return to the revolving fund any moneys <u>expended for the [so used upon]</u> resale or
- 20 [other] transfer of <u>the</u>[such] land.
