2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:			
3		⇒S	ection 1. KRS 226.040 is amended to read as follows:	
4	<u>(1)</u>	Ever	ry pawnbroker shall keep a register of all loans and purchases of all articles	
5		effec	cted or made by him. The register shall <u>:</u>	
6		<u>(a)</u>	Be reported to an online, Internet-based transaction recording service	
7			accessible to law enforcement agencies;	
8		<u>(b)</u>	Show the dates <i>and the amounts</i> of all loans or purchases, and the names	
9			<u>and:</u>	
10			<u>1. A driver's license;</u>	
11			2. Another state or federally issued picture identification card; or	
12			3. If the identification specified in subparagraph 1. or 2. of this	
13			paragraph is not available, a Social Security number may be accepted;	
14			of all persons who have left any property <i>that has been pawned or sold</i> ; [on	
15			deposit as collateral security, or as a delivery or sale. Opposite the names and	
16			dates shall be written in plain hand a full description of all property purchased	
17			or received on deposit as collateral security, the time when the loan falls due,	
18			the amount of purchase money, the amount loaned and the interest charged.]	
19		<u>(c)</u>	[The register shall]At all times be available[open] to the inspection of any	
20			law enforcement officer of this state when in the discharge of his or her	
21			official duty <u>: and</u> [.]	
22		<u>(d)</u>	Contain a full description of all property purchased or received on deposit	
23			as collateral or security. When requested by law enforcement and pertaining	
24			to an investigation, a photograph of the merchandise shall be made	
25			available to law enforcement if the property is still in the possession of the	
26			pawnbroker. For purposes of this paragraph, "full description" includes	
27			but is not limited to:	

1	<u>1. Make;</u>
2	<u>2. Model;</u>
3	<u>3. Color;</u>
4	<u>4. Size;</u>
5	<u>5. Manufacturer;</u>
6	<u>6. Vintage; and</u>
7	7. Distinguishing marks or characteristics.
8	(2) When secondhand merchandise is sold to a pawnbroker, the merchandise shall
9	be held for a minimum of twelve (12) days before being resold.
10	(3) Prior to the release of property to a representative of law enforcement, the law
11	enforcement representative shall provide to the pawnbroker a case report or other
12	documentation that the item has been reported as stolen.
