- WHEREAS, the process of adoption in Kentucky can be restrictively expensive;

- 4 WHEREAS, the process of adoption in Kentucky is rife with redundancy; and
- 5 WHEREAS, adoption is a valuable component of the lives of many Kentuckians;
- 6 NOW, THEREFORE,
- 7 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the

- 9 → Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission is hereby directed to create an
- 10 Adoption Task Force to study the adoption process in Kentucky and throughout the
- 11 United States.
- → Section 2. The task force shall comprehensively investigate adoption in the
- 13 Commonwealth of Kentucky to identify policy options to streamline the adoption process,
- 14 increase efficiency, reduce the timeline of the adoption process, reduce costs, and
- decrease paperwork and redundancy.
- → Section 3. The task force shall also review studies and legislative action by
- other states and the federal government on adoption practices.
- → Section 4. The task force shall be composed of the following members, with
- 19 final membership subject to the consideration and approval of the Legislative Research
- 20 Commission:
- 21 (1) Four members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the
- House, one of whom shall be designated by the Speaker of the House to serve as co-
- chair;
- 24 (2) Four members of the Senate, appointed by the President of the Senate, one of whom
- shall be designated by the President of the Senate to serve as co-chair; and
- 26 (3) Up to two individuals to be recommended by the Governor.
- → Section 5. The task force shall meet at least three times during the 2017 Interim
