A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION relating to the establishment of the Penal Code

- 2 Reform Task Force.
- WHEREAS, Kentucky adopted its current penal code in 1974, after years of study;
- 4 and
- 5 WHEREAS, the penal code has not been revised systematically in 50 years; and
- WHEREAS, the accumulation of small changes over that time has made the penal
- 7 code less clear and less coherent;
- 8 NOW, THEREFORE,
- 9 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
- 10 Commonwealth of Kentucky, the Senate concurring therein:
- → Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission is hereby directed to create
- the Penal Code Reform Task Force to study Kentucky's criminal statutes, both within the
- penal code and without, and develop recommendations for Kentucky's substantive and
- procedural criminal statutes, including sentencing, probation, and parole.
- → Section 2. The Penal Code Reform Task Force shall be composed of the
- 16 following members, with final membership of the task force being subject to the
- 17 consideration and approval of the Legislative Research Commission.
- 18 (1) Two members of the House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker
- of the House, one of whom shall be designated to serve as co-chair;
- 20 (2) Two members of the Senate to be appointed by the President of the Senate,
- 21 one of whom shall be designated to serve as co-chair;
- 22 (3) One member of the House of Representatives to be appointed by the Minority
- 23 Floor Leader of the House;
- 24 (4) One member of the Senate to be appointed by the Minority Floor Leader of
- 25 the Senate;
- 26 (5) The Attorney General or his or her designee;
- 27 (6) The Public Advocate or his or her designee;

1 (7) The commissioner of the Department of Juvenile Justice, or his or her 2 designee;

- 3 (8) The commissioner of the Department of Kentucky State Police, or his or her designee;
- 5 (9) An employee of the Department of Criminal Justice Training, appointed by 6 the secretary of the Justice and Public Safety Cabinet;
- 7 (10) A judge or justice of the Kentucky Court of Justice, appointed by the Chief 8 Justice of the Kentucky Supreme Court;
- 9 (11) A member of the Commonwealth's Attorneys Association, appointed by the association;
- 11 (12) A member of the County Attorneys Association, appointed by the association;
- 12 (13) A member of the Kentucky Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers, 13 appointed by the association;
- 14 (14) A member of the Fraternal Order of Police, appointed by the association;
- 15 (15) A member of the Kentucky Association of Chiefs of Police, appointed by the association;
- 17 (16) A member of the Kentucky Jailers' Association, appointed by the association;
- 18 (17) A faculty member of the University of Kentucky J. David Rosenberg College 19 of Law, appointed by the dean of the college;
- 20 (18) A faculty member of the University of Louisville Louis D. Brandeis School of 21 Law, appointed by the dean of the school; and
- 22 (19) A faculty member of the Salmon P. Chase College of Law at Northern 23 Kentucky University, appointed by the dean of the college.
- Section 3. The Penal Code Reform Task Force shall meet at least three times during the 2024 Interim and shall submit its findings, legislative recommendations, or a memorandum to the Legislative Research Commission no later than December 1, 2024 for referral to the Interim Joint Committee on Judiciary. If legislative recommendations

1 are submitted, the Legislative Research Commission may refer the recommendations to

- 2 the appropriate committee or committees of jurisdiction in advance of the 2025 Regular
- 3 Session of the Kentucky General Assembly.

- 5 Legislative Research Commission shall have the authority to alternatively assign the
- 6 issues identified herein to an interim joint committee or subcommittee thereof, and to
- 7 designate a study completion date.
