

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION designating a portion of Kentucky Route 210 in LaRue
2 County in honor and loving memory of Hodgenville Police Officer Mark Taulbee.

3 WHEREAS, Officer Mark Taulbee passed away on September 16, 2012, after an
4 automobile accident which occurred during the high-speed pursuit of a suspect; and

5 WHEREAS, Officer Mark Taulbee was a native of Whitesburg and Cecilia,
6 Kentucky; and

7 WHEREAS, Officer Mark Taulbee had served with the Hodgenville Police
8 Department for 13 months and had previously served with the Morgan County Police
9 Department and the Butler County Sheriff's Office; and

10 WHEREAS, Officer Mark Taulbee was preceded in death by his mother, Clara
11 (Sexton) Taulbee. He is survived by his father, Manson Taulbee; son, Mark Austin
12 Taulbee; daughter, Audra Beth Taulbee; sister, Sheila Adams; brothers, Mason R.
13 Taulbee, Bill W. Taulbee, and Wayne Taulbee; and

14 WHEREAS, Officer Mark Taulbee dedicated his life to serving others, caring for
15 others, and saving others, and he courageously gave his life while serving his community;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, it is appropriate that the sacrifice of Officer Mark Taulbee be
18 memorialized and this highway designation will serve as a reminder of the
19 Commonwealth's appreciation for his service;

20 NOW, THEREFORE,

21 ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

22 ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 210 in
23 LaRue County, from the intersection of Kentucky Route 1618 to the Green/Taylor county
24 line, as the "Officer Mark Taulbee Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the
25 effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signs denoting this designation.
