Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet shall, within 30 days of the effective date
of this Resolution, erect highway signs on Kentucky Route 39 near Garrard County High
School that read "GCHS, Home of 2019 National Beta Convention Competition
Qualifiers Alex Canada, Dylan Driskell, Maddie Jordan, and Emma Warren." The signs
placed under the section shall remain in place for at least one year.
