2	WHEREAS, in time, the harsh reality of wintertime will give way to spring and the
3	month of June, National Dairy Month; and
4	WHEREAS, since 1937, National Dairy Month has been commemorated
5	throughout the nation as a way to highlight the many nutrition-rich dairy foods available
6	to consumers and spotlight the contributions that dairy farmers and others involved in the
7	dairy supply chain make to the national economy; and
8	WHEREAS, dairy foods deliver a unique combination of nine essential nutrients
9	and provide health benefits, especially bone health, including about 67 percent of the
10	calcium available in the U.S. food supply; and
11	WHEREAS, dairy is an important component in the overall farm economy in
12	Kentucky; and
13	WHEREAS, Kentucky is the home of almost 60,000 milk cows being raised on 630
14	dairy farms; and
15	WHEREAS, the typical dairy farm in the Commonwealth has a herd of about 92
16	cows, with each cow providing an average of 2,101 gallons of milk per year; and
17	WHEREAS, Kentucky's dairy farms, which are 24/7 operations, produce about 122
18	million gallons of the nutritious liquid per year; and
19	WHEREAS, cash receipts from the sale of milk by the state's dairy farms amount to
20	approximately \$192 million per year; and
21	WHEREAS, the dairy industry not only involves dairy producers, but also those
22	who haul the product, milk processing plants located throughout the state, and others who
23	make up the complement of people involved in putting dairy products onto store shelves;
24	NOW, THEREFORE,
25	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
