2	WHEREAS, Hodgenville, the seat of LaRue County, was founded by Robert
3	Hodgen, a Justice of the Peace who later served as a Kentucky State Representative; and
4	WHEREAS, after Hodgen's death in 1810, his widow, Sarah LaRue Hodgen, and
5	his sons, Isaac and John, petitioned the Hardin County Court to establish a town on the
6	plantation of their late husband and father; and
7	WHEREAS, on February 9, 1818, Hodgenville was established; and
8	WHEREAS, on February 18, 2018, Lincoln Days Celebration, Inc., will host a
9	luncheon in rightful commemoration of Hodgenville's bicentennial celebration; and
10	WHEREAS, in acknowledgement of this event, this body thanks all the city leaders
11	and volunteers in Hodgenville for their exemplary service to their beloved home
12	community, and commends the many sacrifices made by the generations of families who
13	have made Hodgenville one of this Commonwealth's true jewels;
14	NOW, THEREFORE,
15	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
16	Commonwealth of Kentucky:
17	→Section 1. The members of the House of Representatives hereby honor
18	Hodgenville upon the celebration of its bicentennial.
19	Section 2. When the House of Representatives adjourns this day, it does so in
20	honor of Hodgenville.
