3	WHEREAS, in January 2022, Canadian citizens who disapproved of their
4	government's response to the COVID-19 pandemic and their restrictive policies took to
5	the roadways and streets to protest; and
6	WHEREAS, named the Freedom Convoy, citizens across Canada took trucks and
7	other vehicles to the capitol in an effort show their government their opposition to the
8	onerous mandates imposed on the people of Canada; and
9	WHEREAS, instead of meeting with the citizens in a respectful discussion, seeking
10	understanding of their grievances and frustrations, the Trudeau Administration took
11	extreme actions to disperse the truckers and their supporters; and
12	WHEREAS, Prime Minister Trudeau invoked the Emergencies Act which allowed
13	the government to order financial institutions to freeze the assets and refuse service to all
14	Canadians who had contributed to the protest through fundraising sites, suspended
15	insurance policies, and targeted not only regular banking accounts but cryptocurrency
16	accounts; and
17	WHEREAS, in a move rarely seen outside tyrannical regimes, not only were the
18	protesters themselves targeted but anyone who supported them through online fundraising
19	sites were effectively removed from society for daring to voice opposition; and
20	WHEREAS, the principles of the United States of America and the Commonwealth
21	of Kentucky support the right of individuals to speak freely to government without
22	penalty; and
23	WHEREAS, the General Assembly supports and affirms freedom of speech,
24	freedom of assembly, and property rights, and condemns any government's attempts to
25	silence a political movement through asset seizure;
