

1 A RESOLUTION honoring Seygan Robins from Mercer County High School upon
2 being named Kentucky's Miss Basketball for the 2017-2018 season.

3 WHEREAS, in 1976, the Miss Basketball Award was established in Kentucky to
4 recognize the most outstanding girls basketball player in the Commonwealth; and

5 WHEREAS, Mercer County High School's Seygan Robins has been named
6 Kentucky's Miss Basketball for the 2017-2018 season; and

7 WHEREAS, Seygan Robins led Mercer County High School to an extraordinary
8 season as the Titans finished with 36 wins and only three losses, winning the Kentucky
9 High School Athletic Association Girls Sweet Sixteen basketball state championship the
10 second consecutive season. Ms. Robins was named the Sweet Sixteen Most Valuable
11 Player for the second straight year; and

12 WHEREAS, Seygan Robins averaged 14.6 points per game and 2.8 rebounds per
13 game while shooting 42.8 percent from the field, 31.9 percent from three-point range, and
14 77.3 percent from the free-throw line. A 5-7 guard, Ms. Robins finished her career with
15 more than 2,500 points, 800 assists, and 500 steals; and

16 WHEREAS, Seygan Robins has signed to play for the University of Louisville, and
17 this body grants her best wishes as she takes her talents to the Atlantic Coast Conference;
18 and

19 WHEREAS, Miss Basketball Seygan Robins joins Mr. Basketball Trevon Faulkner
20 to give Mercer County High School the first-ever a sweep by the same school of the
21 Commonwealth's highest high school basketball awards for players;
