- WHEREAS, the Easter Bunny is both a magical symbol in folklore and, to children
- visiting him in America's shopping malls, mildly upsetting; and
- WHEREAS, rabbits are incredibly prolific, and are among the tamest and most
- docile creatures in nature, so uncaring that they can lose footraces to much slower
- animals that they should not logically lose and take it in stride; and
- WHEREAS, for these reasons and many more, this body acknowledges the place
- 16 rabbits play both in our real lives and in the fictional imaginings created by our great
- writers, and in so doing commends rabbits for serving as a symbol of life, of spring's
- enduring beauty, and of the extraordinary wonder of nature;
