A RESOLUTION celebrating the 210th birthday of Abraham Lincoln.

- 2 WHEREAS, Abraham Lincoln was born on February 12, 1809, in a log cabin on
  3 Sinking Spring Farm near Hodgenville, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, Abraham Lincoln would leave Kentucky along with his family in
1815, but his roots in this Commonwealth would be deep and indelible, and he would
carry with him the spirit of Kentucky throughout his extraordinary life; and

WHEREAS, after four terms in the Illinois House of Representatives, Abraham
Lincoln was elected to the United States House of Representatives in 1846. In 1860,
owing to his famous debates with Stephen A. Douglas, Lincoln would defeat Douglas and
two other candidates to become the 16th President of the United States; and

WHEREAS, for his enduring ties to this Commonwealth and for all he achieved as President—including his resolute leadership during the Civil War and his courageous endorsement of emancipation—Abraham Lincoln stands as a model for all Kentuckians even today, and thus it is rightful that this body honor him on the occasion of his 210th birthday; and

WHEREAS, in so doing, the members pause today to reflect on the greatness of our 17 16th President, and to acknowledge his presence in this chamber both as a statesman of 18 the first order and as a Kentuckian who has shaped the very firmament of this 19 Commonwealth;

20 NOW, THEREFORE,

21 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the 22 Commonwealth of Kentucky:

23 → Section 1. The members of the House of Representatives hereby celebrate
24 Abraham Lincoln's 210th birthday, and acknowledge his home community of
25 Hodgenville and its residents for all they do to keep President Lincoln's legacy alive.

26 → Section 2. When the House of Representatives adjourns this day, it does so in
27 celebration of Abraham Lincoln's 210th birthday.
