- 14 States Department of Agriculture and Department for Health and Human Services
- 15 recommends consuming three servings of dairy products, including milk, each day as part
- of a balanced diet; and
- WHEREAS, National Dairy Month has been celebrated since 1939 as a way to
- promote the consumption of dairy products and to thank those involved in the dairy
- industry for their labors;
