

A RESOLUTION honoring the Blueprint for Kentucky's Children and adjourning in honor of Children's Advocacy Day, January 14, 2016.

WHEREAS, every child in Kentucky deserves the chance to live in a thriving community, possess a strong family, and have the opportunity to be a successful kid; and

WHEREAS, the Blueprint for Kentucky's Children is a coalition of nonprofit, private, and public organizations committed to making Kentucky a great place to be a kid; and

WHEREAS, the Blueprint for Kentucky's Children calls for policies that promote thriving communities, strong families, and successful kids in order to create a prosperous future for Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, Children's Advocacy Day was established 12 years ago in 2004 as an effort to raise the profile of children's issues among Kentucky's elected leaders; and

WHEREAS, Children's Advocacy Day allows significant discussion of the issues on the Blueprint for Kentucky's Children agenda; and

WHEREAS, giving a voice to young people through Children's Advocacy Day serves as a powerful vehicle, reminding us all that Kentucky's children are the key to a sustained and prosperous future for the Commonwealth;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

➔Section 1. When the House of Representatives adjourns this day, it does so in honor of Children's Advocacy Day, January 14, 2016.

➔Section 2. The House of Representatives acknowledges the Blueprint for Kentucky's Children for its role in improving outcomes for the children of the Commonwealth.
