2	WHEREAS, Simpson County was created by the Kentucky General Assembly on		
3	January 28, 1819, the new county having been drawn from portions of Allen, Logan, and		
4	Warren Counties; and		
5	WHEREAS, Simpson County gained prominence in its first decade as a popular site		
6	for fighting duels with deadly weapons, a practice still proscribed today in the oath of		
7	office taken by each member of this legislative body; and		
8	WHEREAS, the frontier that is now Simpson County was the birthplace of Jim		
9	Bowie, father of the Bowie knife and hero at the Alamo, and the birthplace of Alexander		
10	Majors, freight hauler to the United States Cavalry and co-founder of the Pony Express		
11	and		
12	WHEREAS, Simpson County emerged from the hardships of the Civil War to		
13	develop a robust and proud agricultural community; and		
14	WHEREAS, in the years before World War II, Simpson County became the second-		
15	largest mule trading center in the nation; and		
16	WHEREAS, Simpson County's Mule Day Celebration in 1940 was broadcas		
17	nationwide by CBS Radio; and		
18	WHEREAS, the Kentucky Chamber of Commerce chose Franklin, the seat of		
19	Simpson County, as Kentucky's Number One City in 1956-57 and again in 1958; and		
20	WHEREAS, Simpson County in recent decades has recruited a strong		
21	manufacturing base, resulting in a prosperous, diversified economy; and		
22	WHEREAS, Simpson County is well known today as the site of the Johnny Cash-		
23	June Carter wedding in 1968, and as the birthplace of golfer Kenny Perry and actress		
24	Annie Potts; and		
25	WHEREAS, the residents of Simpson County will be celebrating their bicentennial		
26	throughout this year and the next, as the city of Franklin marks its 200th anniversary in		
27	2020;
