A RESOLUTION proclaiming June as Scleroderma Awareness Month in Kentucky.
 WHEREAS, scleroderma is a chronic connective tissue disease which affects
 approximately 4,000 people in Kentucky and over 300,000 people across the country; and
 WHEREAS, an autoimmune rheumatic disease, scleroderma is the buildup of

5 collagen which causes a tightening of skin and connective tissue; and

6 WHEREAS, the symptoms of scleroderma can vary greatly for each person, ranging
7 from very mild, in which mobility is somewhat limited, to life-threatening, in which
8 internal organs are damaged, leading to severe complications, even death; and

9 WHEREAS, prompt and proper diagnosis and treatment by qualified physicians can
10 minimize the symptoms and lessen the chance for irreversible damage, but there is
11 currently no known cure for the disease; and

WHEREAS, increasing awareness of scleroderma and educating the populace about
the disease have the potential to encourage more research in hopes of improving
treatment options and finding a cure;

15 NOW, THEREFORE,

16 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the 17 Commonwealth of Kentucky:

Section 1. The House of Representatives does hereby proclaim June as
 Scleroderma Awareness Month in Kentucky to promote increased awareness and
 education and encourage further research and treatment of the disease.
