- WHEREAS, as screening rates have risen by 50 percent, colorectal cancer incidence
- 11 rates and morality rates have declined. This decrease in incidence means that every year,
- 12 30 percent fewer Kentuckians are diagnosed with colon cancer; and

- efforts of multiple partners working together, is proving to be life-saving for Kentuckians;
