3	WHEREAS, almost every family in the Commonwealth is either directly or
4	indirectly affected by addiction; and
5	WHEREAS, in 2019, 1,316 Kentuckians died from drug overdoses, the leading
6	cause of accidental deaths in Kentucky, with the largest deaths occurring in the 35-44 age
7	group; and
8	WHEREAS, the economic and societal costs of addiction include strained health
9	care, child welfare, social service, correctional, and judicial systems, as well as significant
10	loss in workforce productivity; and
11	WHEREAS, addiction should be recognized as a disease in order to encourage
12	treatment and reduce fear and stigma; and
13	WHEREAS, recovery is a long-term process that requires a supportive community
14	and access to necessary resources; and
15	WHEREAS, achieving and sustaining successful recovery shall incorporate a
16	wholeness approach to overall personal well-being; and
17	WHEREAS, addiction cannot be solved by government alone; and
18	WHEREAS, a strategy for addressing this epidemic is for public and private
19	partnerships to provide individualized, comprehensive, long-term supports that focus on
20	vital components of addiction recovery including: effective and accessible health care to
21	treat physical, mental, and behavioral health; employment and educational opportunities;
22	safe and affordable housing; transportation for treatment and to support recovery; and
23	childcare to encourage workforce participation and stop the cycle of addiction;
