2	medical services personnel, coroners, and deputy coroners killed in the line of duty.
3	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
4	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 72 IS CREATED TO
5	READ AS FOLLOWS:
6	(1) The coroner shall ensure that the remains of a police officer, firefighter, or
7	emergency medical services personnel, as defined in KRS 61.315, or a coroner or
8	deputy coroner, killed in the line of duty are returned to the care and custody of
9	that person's family or other party responsible for the person's final
10	arrangements in a professional manner so as to obscure the contour of the
11	decedent's remains. Upon the wishes of the family or other responsible party, the
12	coroner shall ensure that the decedent is covered by an American flag in honor of
13	his or her service.
14	(2) The coroner may make arrangements with the family or other responsible party
15	of a decedent described in subsection (1) of this section to have the individual
16	returned to the care and custody of that person's family or other party responsible
17	for the person's final arrangement by a funeral home or a designated transport
18	service. In that case, the decedent shall be transported in the manner set out in
19	subsection (1) of this section.
