1	AN ACT relating to information on emergency use drugs and declaring an
2	emergency.
3	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
4	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS 217.005 TO 217.215 IS CREATED
5	TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
6	(1) As required in 21 U.S.C. sec. 360bbb-3, any individual who administers an
7	unapproved drug that has been approved for emergency use by the commissioner
8	of the United States Food and Drug Administration shall inform the individual to
9	whom the drug is administered of the following:
10	(a) That the drug has been authorized for emergency use;
11	(b) The significant known and potential benefits and risks of such use, and the
12	extent to which such benefits and risks are unknown;
13	(c) The option to accept or refuse administration of the drug;
14	(d) Medical consequences, if any, of refusing administration of the drug; and
15	(e) Alternatives to the drug that are available and their benefits and risks.
16	(2) No individual in the Commonwealth shall be required by any person as defined in
17	KRS 446.010 to have administered an unapproved drug that has been approved
18	for emergency use by the commissioner of the United States Food and Drug
19	Administration.
20	→ Section 2. Whereas the Commonwealth of Kentucky has a paramount interest in
21	protecting the rights of all citizens to make informed decisions about their health, an
22	emergency is declared to exist, and this Act takes effect upon its passage and approval by
23	the Governor or upon its otherwise becoming a law.
