6		(a) The[the] director of the Division of Emergency Management of the
7		Department of Military Affairs, who shall serve as chair; [also be a member.]
8		(b) The executive director of the Department of Military Affairs, who shall
9		serve as vice chair and shall serve as chair in the absence of the chair;
10		(c) The Other members shall include, but not be limited to, the executive
11		director of the Kentucky Fire Commission or the executive director's
12		designee[,]; and
13		(d) Representatives [representatives] of the Energy and Environment Cabinet, the
14		state fire marshal, the Department of Kentucky State Police, the Office of the
15		Attorney General, the Department of Agriculture, affected industry, local
16		government, health services, environmental interests, and other persons who
17		have technical expertise in the emergency response field as the Governor
18		deems appropriate.
19	(2)	Members of the commission shall be appointed by the Governor. All appointments
20		shall be for a term of two (2) years. Members shall serve until their successors are
21		appointed and qualified and shall be eligible for reappointment.
22	(3)	The commission shall meet not less than semi-annually, or as convened by the
23		[chairman]chair, vice chair, or upon written petition of a majority of commission
24		members to the chair or vice chair.
25	(4)	If a member misses three (3) consecutive meetings of the full commission or three
26		(3) meetings in two (2) consecutive years, the position shall be declared vacant by
27		the commission. In these cases, the Governor shall make an appointment to fill the
