10	(2) A local board of education shall prepare of	r approve a test composed of the
11	questions described in subsection (1) of this se	ction and shall disseminate the test
12	to all public high schools of the district. The	e test shall be administered by the
13	public high schools in each district.	
14	(3) A public high school shall provide each stude	nt with the opportunity to take the
15	test as many times as necessary for the student	to pass the test. A student shall not
16	receive a regular high school diploma until the	student passes the test.
17	(4) A student passes the test if at least sixty pe	ercent (60%) of the questions are
18	answered correctly.	
19	(5) Provisions of this section shall be sul	bject to the requirements and
20	accommodations of a student's individualized	l education program as defined in
21	KRS 158.281 or a Section 504 Plan as defined	in KRS 156.027.
