2	Be it	enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3		→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 158 IS CREATED TO
4	REA	D AS FOLLOWS:
5	<u>(1)</u>	Beginning on July 1, 2018, to graduate from a Kentucky public high school with
6		a regular diploma, a student shall pass a civics test composed of one hundred
7		(100) questions drawn from those that are set forth within the civics test
8		administered by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services to
9		persons seeking to become naturalized citizens.
10	<u>(2)</u>	A local board of education shall prepare or approve a test composed of the
11		questions described in subsection (1) of this section and shall disseminate the test
12		to all public high schools of the district. The test shall be administered by the
13		public high schools in each district.
14	<u>(3)</u>	A public high school shall provide each student with the opportunity to take the
15		test as many times as necessary for the student to pass the test. A student shall not
16		receive a regular high school diploma until the student passes the test.
17	<u>(4)</u>	A student passes the test if at least sixty percent (60%) of the questions are
18		answered correctly.
19	<u>(5)</u>	Provisions of this section shall be subject to the requirements and
20		accommodations of a student's individualized education program as defined in
21		KRS 158.281 or a Section 504 Plan as defined in KRS 156.027.
