3		→ S	ection 1. KRS 171.420 is amended to read as follows:
4	(1)	The	State <u>Libraries</u> , Archives, and Records Commission is hereby created and shall
5		be a	seventeen (17) member body constituted as follows:
6		(a)	The state librarian or his <u>or her</u> designee, who shall be the
7			<u>chairperson</u> [chairman] of the commission;
8		(b)	The secretary of the Education and Workforce Development Cabinet or his or
9			<u>her</u> designee, who shall serve as vice chairperson;
10		(c)	The Auditor of Public Accounts or his or her designee;
11		(d)	The state law librarian [Chief Justice of the Supreme Court] or his or her
12			designee;
13		(e)	The director of the Legislative Research Commission or his <u>or her</u> designee;
14		(f)	The Attorney General or his <u>or her</u> designee;
15		(g)	The <u>executive</u> director of the <u>Kentucky Military Heritage Commission or a</u>
16			designee of the commission [Office for Policy and Management in the Office
17			of the Controller or his designee];
18		(h)	The executive director of the Commonwealth Office of Technology or [her or]
19			his <u>or her</u> designee;
20		(i)	The president of the Kentucky Association of School Librarians or his or
21			her designee [One (1) member appointed by the Governor from a list of three
22			(3) persons submitted by the president of the University of Kentucky];
23		(j)	The executive director[One (1) member appointed by the Governor from a list
24			of three (3) persons submitted by the president] of the Kentucky Historical
25			Society or his or her designee;
26		(k)	The executive director[One (1) member appointed by the Governor from a list

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of three (3) persons submitted by the president] of the Kentucky Library

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1		Association or his or her designee;
2		(l) The president of the Council on Postsecondary Education or his or her
3		<u>designee</u> [One (1) member appointed by the Governor from a list of seven (7)
4		persons with one (1) name submitted by each of the presidents of the state
5		universities and colleges];
6		(m) Four (4) citizens at large appointed by the Governor, including one (1)
7		member representing library users with disabilities, one (1) member
8		representing disadvantaged persons, and two (2) members representing
9		<u>library users</u> ; and
10		(n) One (1) member, who shall not be an elected official, appointed by the
11		Governor from a list of three (3) persons, with one (1) name submitted by
12		each of the presidents of the Kentucky League of Cities, the Kentucky
13		Association of Counties, and the Kentucky Association of School
14		Administrators.
15	(2)	Vacancies for appointed members shall be filled by the Governor in the same
16		manner as initial appointments are made. All appointed members shall serve for a
17		term of three (3)[four (4)] years, except when making the appointments under
18		subsection (3) of this section, two (2)[provided that one (1) of the initial
19		appointments] shall be for a term of [four (4) years, one (1) for] three (3) years, two
20		(2)[one (1)] for two (2) years, and one (1) for one (1) year.
21	(3)	On the effective date of this Act, all terms of gubernatorial appointees made prior
22		to the effective date of this Act shall expire, and the Governor shall appoint five
23		(5) members to the commission in accordance with paragraphs (m) and (n) of
24		subsection (1) of this section.
25	<u>(4)</u>	The commission shall be the state advisory council on libraries and shall advise
26		the Department for Libraries and Archives on matters relating to federal and state
27		library development issues, archives and records management, federal and state

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funding, public library standards, and other federal and state library service
<u>issues</u> . The commission shall have the authority to review and approve schedules
for retention and destruction of records submitted by state and local agencies. In all
cases, the commission shall determine questions which relate to destruction of
public records, and their decision shall be binding on the parties concerned and
final, except that the commission may reconsider or modify its actions upon the
agreement of a simple majority of the membership present and voting.
